

Municipalité de Clarendon Points Forts du budget 2023

Après une autre année sans augmentation du taux d'imposition, le Conseil municipal a adopté un budget équilibré pour 2023 qui maintient à nouveau le même taux d'imposition.

Globalement, les recettes (y compris les montants provenant des taxes et des subventions) pour 2023 s'élèveront à 2,977,088.00\$, ce qui représente une augmentation des recettes de 0,041 % par rapport à 2022. Les dépenses s'élèvent à 3 041 816 \$ pour 2023, soit une augmentation de 10,2 % par rapport à 2022.

Un total de 575 146,00 \$ sera réinvesti pour couvrir les dépenses en capital prévues pour 2023, y compris un camion chasse-neige avec ponceuse ainsi qu'un ajout au bureau municipal pour créer une salle d'archives appropriée.

La plupart des augmentations des dépenses pour 2023 sont pour les parts municipales payées à la MRC de Pontiac (augmentation pour 2023 de 37%), le transport et la sécurité publique.

Conformément aux communications habituelles, le document budgétaire 2023 sera joint aux factures d'impôts 2023.

Municipality of Clarendon Budget 2023 Highlights

After another year with no increase to the tax rate, the Municipal Council passed a balanced budget for 2023 that again maintains the same tax rate.

Overall, the revenues (Including amounts from taxes and grants) for 2023 will be in the amount of \$2,977,088.00 which represents an increase in revenue of 0.041% over 2022. The expenditures in the amount of \$3,041,816 for 2023, is an increase over 2022 expenditures of \$10.2%.

A total of \$ 575,146.00 will be reinvested to cover capital expenditures planned for 2023 including a Plow Truck with Sander as well as an addition to the Municipal Office to create a proper archive room.

Most of the increases in expenditures for 2023 are for Municipal shares paid to the MRC Pontiac (increase for 2023 of 37%), Transportation and Public Security.

As per normal communications, the 2023 budget document will be included with the 2023 tax invoices.
